- 1 C Ireland.
- 2 C 4 – Spain, France, Netherlands and the United Kingdom all tied for first place.
- 3 A Austria.
- 4 A She was 13, making her the youngest ever winner.
- 5 Abba! – but this didn't stop Waterloo from reaching number one in the UK singles chart just two weeks later.

ROUND 2 – FAMOUS NAMES

- 6 A Cliff Richard, who represented the UK twice.

ROUND 3 – TRULY TRIVIAL

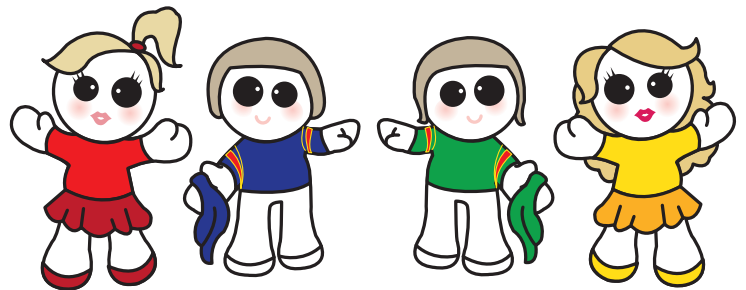
- 11 B She sang her song in four languages.
