DEAR FRIENDS,

It is my pleasure to welcome you to The Auction 2022 and back to the wonderful Christie's.

This year, Terrence Higgins Trust enters its 40th anniversary. Throughout this year and next, you'll see exciting campaigns, events and activities to get involved in, but it's also a time of remembrance and reflection. What strikes me the most as I look back is seeing how HIV has changed since the 1980s. It's no longer a death sentence, and people on effective treatment can't pass HIV on to their partners and can expect to live a long, healthy life. But one thing that hasn't changed is the stigma around HIV.

Stigma can affect all people living with HIV, sometimes at different points throughout our lives – it could be the attitude of a friend or family member or a negative experience at the GP. While medical advances and dedicated support services can enable people to live well with HIV, the attitudes of others, often due to misinformation or outdated views, can cause us damage and hurt, and even affect the care and treatment we get from others.

It's why campaigns like *Life Really Changed* are so important, celebrating the successes of people not just living with HIV but achieving great things, reaching their goals and challenging perceptions of what it 'looks like' to live with HIV. The virus no longer needs to limit people's lives, but unless we challenge it and be a part of the change, stigma will continue to.

Thank you to The Auction Committee, for their unwavering and enthusiastic support – we couldn't do this without you. Thank you to all of you here this evening and showing your support online, we are delighted to be back and hope that everyone has a fantastic evening.

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TOGETHER WE'RE TAKING A STAND AGAINST STIGMA

As Terrence Higgins Trust enters its 40th year of activism, care and remembrance, it's more important than ever that we work to tackle HIV stigma. We've made huge strides in HIV treatment – people on effective treatment live normal lifespans and are unable to pass on HIV – but 40 years on, stigma and lack of understanding are still widespread.

Stigma is one of the key reasons why people avoid getting tested, and it can affect the lives of people living with HIV. It's still the case that many people's understanding of HIV is stuck in the '80s, and that can mean attitudes are stuck there too – we need to change that.

HIV has changed is one of our key messages from our recent *Life Really Changed* campaign which gets the word out that HIV shouldn't stop you doing anything you want to do. It's thanks to your support that we've been able to get this message out to so many people and help to break down HIV stigma.

By working to tackle HIV stigma we work to improve the lives of people living with HIV and to finally bring an end to the epidemic.

Your support helps us train Positive Voices speakers on how to share their story to tackle the stigma and discrimination around HIV. Thanks to you we can also help support people living with HIV to overcome the barriers they might face from stigma through our counselling and support services.

Together we can end stigma so people living with HIV can get on with life.

Despite being diagnosed many years previously, I still find there are ups and downs. Living with HIV can be hard, sometimes the stigma that you experience can get you down. It's usually from people who don't know the facts, but I've even had stigmatising comments from healthcare staff and my GP. Becoming a Positive Voices speaker was a big part of coming to terms with my diagnosis and doing my part to end the ignorance behind the stigma.

Just **16%** of people know that people living with HIV cannot pass on the virus if they are on effective treatment¹. Stigma that affects people living with HIV also stops others from getting tested. The more people who test and get onto effective treatment so they can't pass on HIV, the fewer HIV transmissions will happen.



14% of people with HIV experienced discrimination in a healthcare setting with 18% avoiding healthcare when they needed it, 11% denied or refused a treatment or procedure that they needed².

Nearly **half** of UK adults wrongly think that you can contract HIV from kissing, sharing a glass, spitting, from a public toilet seat, and coughing³. Outdated information can result in prejudice and discrimination against people living with HIV.

Stigma around HIV can have a devastating impact on our lives. But with the right tools and support, it doesn't have to. It was through Terrence Higgins Trust's mental health support that I first discovered the Positive Voices programme. Now it's like therapy for me, I have a voice. As a speaker for the charity, I am helping to challenge stigma by telling, and owning, my story.

Salgado graduated with an MA in Fine Art from Chelsea College of Art in 2009, and currently lives and works in London, UK. He has exhibited extensively worldwide including London, New York, Cape Town, Basel, Zagreb, Toronto, and Miami. Forthcoming solo exhibitions include *A Never Setting Sun* at BEERS London, (May 2022); as well as his Tokyo debut with MAKI Gallery, Tokyo, Japan (autumn 2022).

In 2017, Salgado was the youngest artist to receive a survey-exhibition at The Canadian High Commission in London. In March 2019, he entered the secondary market with a piece in a Strauss & Co auction in South Africa that doubled its estimate.

Salgado's paintings have been collected extensively in both private and public collections, including the Government of Canada, the Jordanian Royal Family, Simmons & Simmons, and the Esquinazi Collection.

Patrick Hughes lives and works in London. He is widely recognised as one of the major painters of contemporary British art. His solo show in 1961 was the first by a British Pop Artist. His work is in thousands of private and public collections including the British Council, the Victoria & Albert Museum, the Tate Gallery, the British Academy and the British Library.

Of *Aroundbow*, Hughes says: "We usually see rainbows as part of an arc, part of a circle. If you see one from an aeroplane or at Victoria Falls you discover they are actually giant rings until the Earth gets in the way. I have imagined a reflected rainbow making a perfect hoop with an imperfect lifebelt to save you."

Frea Buckler was born in Cambridge in 1974 and studied at Central Saint Martin's College and the UWE in Bristol, where she continues to live and work. She has exhibited internationally in New York, Dublin, Denver and Berlin and widely in the UK including being selected four times for the Royal Academy Summer Exhibition and two solo shows with Smithson Gallery at Jealous Gallery London. She has worked on commissions for Facebook, London Charing Cross Hospital, Fora Space and Ginkgo Projects.

Buckler is a multidisciplinary artist applying her visual language of hard-edged abstraction to screenprint, sculpture and installation. Central to her practice is the interplay between the conscious and subconscious, balancing both reason and intuition to create lively one-off works made up of deeply saturated geometric forms.

Antony Gormley is widely acclaimed for his sculptures, installations and public artworks that investigate the relationship of the human body to space. His work has developed the potential opened up by sculpture since the 1960s through a critical engagement with both his own body and those of others in a way that confronts fundamental questions of where human beings stand in relation to nature and the cosmos. Gormley continually tries to identify the space of art as a place of becoming in which new behaviours, thoughts and feelings can arise.

Gormley was awarded the Turner Prize in 1994, and received an OBE in 1997 with a knighthood following in 2014. Gormley has been a Royal Academician since 2003.

British artist Conrad Shawcross RA specialises in mechanical sculptures based on philosophical and scientific ideas. He is the youngest living member of the Royal Academy of Arts.



'O, what a world of unseen visions and heard silences, this insubstantial country of the mind! What ineffable essences, these touchless rememberings and unshowable reveries! And the privacy of it all!' – Julian Jaynes

Shawcross says: "The name bicameral comes from 'the origin of consciousness in the breakdown of the bicameral mind', by Julian Jaynes; Jaynes' book theorises that consciousness evolved out of the use of language, particularly metaphor. The sculpture is a progression of bifurcating and trifurcating elements that fan out from a stem loosely forming two hemispheres or sides. The work is in some ways an arcadian symbol for reason, humanity, rationalism, progress, whilst the abstract modular structure oscillates between recognizable natural systems such as neural pathways, a set of lungs, or even a schematized tree itself, but in the end it remains elusive to definition."

The piece was created entirely without welding, using techniques drawn from Japanese wood joinery.

London-based artist Italian Leonardo Frigo studied Art Restoration at the International University of Art in Venice, afterwards working in the restoration sector at Cathedral of Notre Dame of Chartres. For several years he actively painted mostly string instruments, creating this unique art form with the purpose of combining music, art and literature in a single object. Leonardo has participated in successful exhibitions in Europe and beyond, including Italy, South Korea, France and England. In general, his biographical illustrations have gained worldwide acclaim.

In December 2020, after five years of work and research, Leonardo finished his 'Inferno' collection, a tribute to Dante Alighieri for the celebrations of the 700th anniversary of his death (1321-2021). This piece is part of the collection.

London-based artist Curtis Holder's work focuses on people and the human form, using graphite and coloured pencils on paper to observe life, convey emotions and tell stories. In 2020, Holder won Sky Arts Portrait Artist of the Year, a national portraiture competition in the UK. His winning commission of world renowned ballet dancer Carlos Acosta is now part of the permanent collection at the Birmingham Museum and Art Gallery.

- 4. The Auctioneer has the right to refuse any bid and to advance the bidding at their absolute discretion, and in the case of error or dispute, to put up an item for bidding again.
- 5. Statements by Terrence Higgins Trust in the catalogue or made orally or in writing elsewhere, regarding the authorship, origin, date, size, medium, attribution, genuineness, provenance, condition or estimated selling price of any Lot are merely statements of opinion, and are not to be relied upon as statements of fact.
