

Though the last 40 years have shown significant progress, we cannot slow down now, we must finish the job.

My biggest and heartfelt congratulations on this historic milestone. May the next one we celebrate signal an end to the HIV/AIDS epidemic for all.

In our 40th Anniversary year, we've been remembering Terry Higgins and reflecting on the work we've accomplished together since 1982. The progress we've made has only been possible with your support – together we've changed HIV in the UK.

We have more to do. We've seen incredible advances in prevention, testing, treatment and care for those living with HIV. But we still have big challenges if we're to make sure that everyone can access the tools to protect themselves and others, so we finally end HIV transmissions.

Thank you for being here with us this evening. You're helping to make history and end new cases of HIV by 2030.

TURNED AWAY FROM PROTECTION

Our recent report revealed that **65%** of people who want to access the highly effective HIV prevention drug PrEP are unable to do so. Two-thirds of people told us that they faced unacceptably long waiting times or were turned away due to the lack of appointments.

We have all fought so hard to get PrEP free on the NHS – we can't let our hard work go to waste. We're working urgently with decision-makers at all levels to ensure that everyone who needs it has access to PrEP. Protecting yourself and your partner shouldn't be a lottery, but a right.



EVERYDAY WE FIGHT MISINFORMATION AND STIGMA

HIV has changed, but we see time and again that many people's views of HIV remain stuck in the decade when Terry Higgins died. Stigma can have devastating consequences in the lives of people living with and affected by HIV.

Stigma can prevent someone from taking a test and getting the care and treatment they need. It can prevent those newly-diagnosed from getting the support they need from those around them.

Our work to educate and dispel myths through changing perceptions and knowledge in the general public is as vital as it's ever been – it's also key to our goal to stop HIV transmissions. If we find and test everyone living with HIV and get them onto treatment so HIV can't be passed on, we can stop an epidemic.

HOW WE STOP AN EPIDEMIC

Last April, opt-out HIV testing in A&E departments in areas with very high prevalence started. This game-changing approach to HIV testing wouldn't have happened without tireless campaigning and the help of our supporters.

Its ground-breaking success is clear: in just the first 100 days, there were 128 new HIV diagnoses and 65 people living with HIV were returned to care. Opt-out testing is good for people's health, stops onward transmission and will save the NHS money by diagnosing people before their health is in crisis.

Over the next year, we need to keep campaigning to ensure that opt-out testing is expanded everywhere. By supporting people living with HIV to get on treatment and live well, we can end new HIV cases by 2030.




Michael Craig-Martin was born in Dublin in 1941 and studied Fine Art at the Yale School of Art and Architecture.

The 'splat' paintings explore a new medium of creating art which grew out of a workshop Davenport held for children in his studio.

Nigel Cox was born in Ireland in 1959. He began to paint while circumnavigating the globe as part of Sir Ranulph Fiennes' Transglobe Expedition in 1989, inspired by the vast and desolate spaces of the North and South poles. He is a five-time finalist in the prestigious Royal Society of

Portrait Painters Annual Exhibition and has exhibited with the Royal Institute of Oil Painters. He shows internationally, from Los Angeles, New York, to Mykonos and Ireland.

As a figurative painter, Cox is fascinated by everyday lives going about their business on the streets of London. By taking an individual out of the frantic crowd around them and painting them in solitude into his minimalist backgrounds, he changes the anonymous to the focal point.



Created in the mid-2000s by an anonymous London artist, Pandemonia is a multi-media conceptual art project centred around a female motif. Pandemonia is a vessel for the artist to travel through society and pass through the media eye into the intersubjective world of myth and brand. Through art exhibitions and public interventions, Pandemonia has been absorbed by the media complex, appearing in print, film and major product advertisements to reach and affect public consciousness.

Tangled Pair depicts the superposition of a pair of legs. Incorporating elements of the figure, Pandemonia considers the delicate system of being in two states at once – the contradictions between the Subatomic and Newtonian reality in Quantum mechanics point to reality as a constructed illusion. Structures and forms in society are not fixed and can be changed.

These male body studies in daylight were taken in Mariano Vivanco's studio in Islington, London. Dan was photographed in the year 2020 and David in 2021. The nude subjects are caught in a state between motion and stillness. Light flows from the side through grand windows over the herculean physiques, creating definition and highlighting form. Exposed to the environment in an empty space, the men have only four walls protecting them from forces outside of their bodies. Strength in vulnerability, the subjects surrender to the energy exchange between themselves and the viewer.

Emin began working with neon in the early 1990s, using the industrial medium to share her passing thoughts and her deepest desires. With her handwriting as the font, the artist's neon sculptures feature deeply personal phrases, but also universally relatable.

The renowned art critic Jonathan Jones has said: 'Emin's neons cast light on the very way she thinks about drawing. She speaks of it in terms of light. She turns words into images, and language into a shining spectacle.'

Kate Malone is a London-based ceramic artist and a ceramic stoneware glaze research expert, producing decorative art pieces. Malone studied at Bristol Polytechnic and the Royal College of Art. Malone is concerned with organic forms and her work is strongly sculptural. Her pots take on the forms of vessels and although her works look as though they should function, that is not their prime motivation, and Malone says she is a 'maker of decorative objects'.

A Friendship Pineapple is a unique decorative ceramic, a symbol of friendship and hospitality and conveying a spirit of joy and celebration. This wall piece has a bar +2 holes hanging mechanism and can be hung inside or outside, and is safe in all elements.

She has exhibited in solo and group shows globally.

Folded Grid focuses on texture and colour, giving the impression of light dancing across an undulating landscape. This work blurs the boundary between painting and sculpture, giving the flat form foil a feeling of depth.

Antony Gormley is widely acclaimed for his sculptures, installations and public artworks that investigate the relationship of the human body to space. Gormley was awarded the Turner Prize in 1994, and received an OBE in 1997 with a knighthood following in 2014. Gormley has been a Royal Academician since 2003.

About this work, the artist says: "Forms of reproduction in which the distinctions between one body becoming two, mitosis and two bodies becoming one and sexual intercourse become interchangeable has long been a preoccupation. I have explored it through drawing and sculpture for over three decades. These drawings start with an organic liquid that pools and, like an amoeba, evolves into binary form: I hope that familiar binaries like self/other, artist/model, creator/created are made pliable, porous and questionable in this process of becoming and emergence."

3 ALL IN THE BEST POSSIBLE TASTE KENNY EVERETT GIANT HANDS

From a lost corner at the television company Mammoth Screen's Fitzrovia studios to Christie's is a journey that these iconic 1980s hands never expected to take, but we promised you one-of-a-kind pieces in this year's Auction.

Comedy legend Kenny Everett had a chequered history, being instrumental in getting Queen's 'Bohemian Rhapsody' released as a single as a DJ for Capital Radio. Later he was a vocal supporter of Margaret Thatcher, but as a closeted gay man, he faced criticism for supporting a Conservative government that enacted Section 28. Everett was later diagnosed with HIV and died of AIDS-related illness in 1995.

James Robert Morrison graduated with an MA Fine Art from Central Saint Martins. He has been shortlisted for the Derwent Art Prize (2022), selected for the Royal Academy Summer Exhibition (2021) and won the Mervyn Metcalf Purchase Prize at the ING Discerning Eye Exhibition (2021). His work is held in the UK Government Art Collection and private collections in the UK, USA and China.

The artist overheard a teenager describing a gay couple as 'never having more than a fag paper between them'. Morrison says: "In my teenage years, I didn't know anyone gay, there were no 'out and proud' public figures and school was an exclusively heteronormative environment due to Section 28. The only gay couples I had to look up to were to be found in my collection of gay porn magazines".

Inspired by this and the play on words, James has created a series of drawings portraying couples from his personal archive of gay porn magazines on the unique and challenging medium: fag (cigarette) papers. Phil and Jacob is the first drawing created from the series. It was shortlisted for the Trinity Buoy Wharf Drawing Prize in 2020 and was awarded a special commendation.
